

2.5.3 Information on Examination Reforms

Reforms in the process and procedure in the conduct of examination/ evaluation, including continuous internal assessment to improve the examination system are as follows:-

- 1) Internal assessment
- 2) Re- Testing :-The pre and post examination activities are integrated,
- 3) Extra classes for some group of students , who lack in attendance (less than 75%), Students who appeared for internal assessment examinations and have faired poorly / not passed .
- 4) Students are provided with the study material via e books & power point presentations.
- 5) Evaluated regularly to assess their progress & performance.
- 6) Clinical quota is also made to be completed by clocking extra clinical hours.
- 7) Complete automation of examination process. :-Complete automation of examination process helps in the successful execution of examination processes such as examination schedule, seating arrangement, attendance monitoring, Marks data entry, preparation of programme wise results
- 8) Examination Management System (EMS) services are available to integrate all the activities in the examination system. The EMS is enabling the student to download the results online.
- 9) Peer review Test and evaluation system (TEA)
- 10) OSCE system.
- 11) Cheating by students is a universal problem -video cameras have been installed in all classes in Examination hall, in part to deter and detect violations of examination protocols.
- 12) Weekly Class Assignments (CAs): - Weekly Class Assignments on topics covered during the week and in daily home assignments are given in class in the form of a short quiz. This ensures that the student has paid attention in the classes and has also attempted all daily home assignments with the required rigor. These assignments have been found to have led to critical-thinking and self assessment in students.
- 13) Remedial Examination: Provision has been made for conduct of remedial examination after every Internal Exams. With this, a student who failed in the internal Exams, can now take up a modular skilling for improvement in their Academic performance

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
