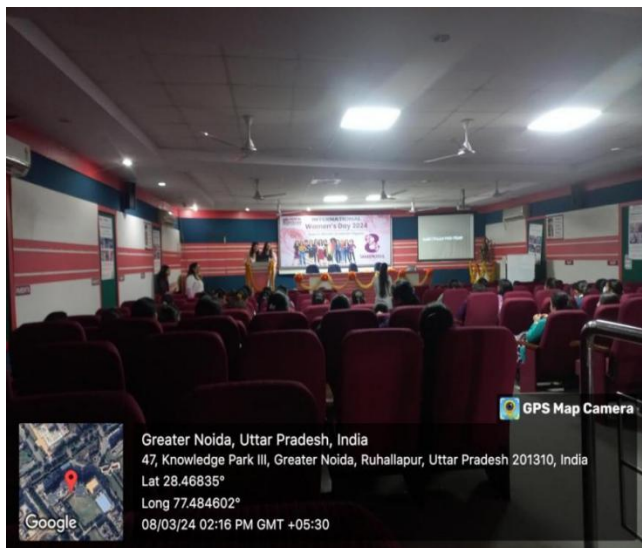
**Report - Women's Day**

**ABSTRACT**

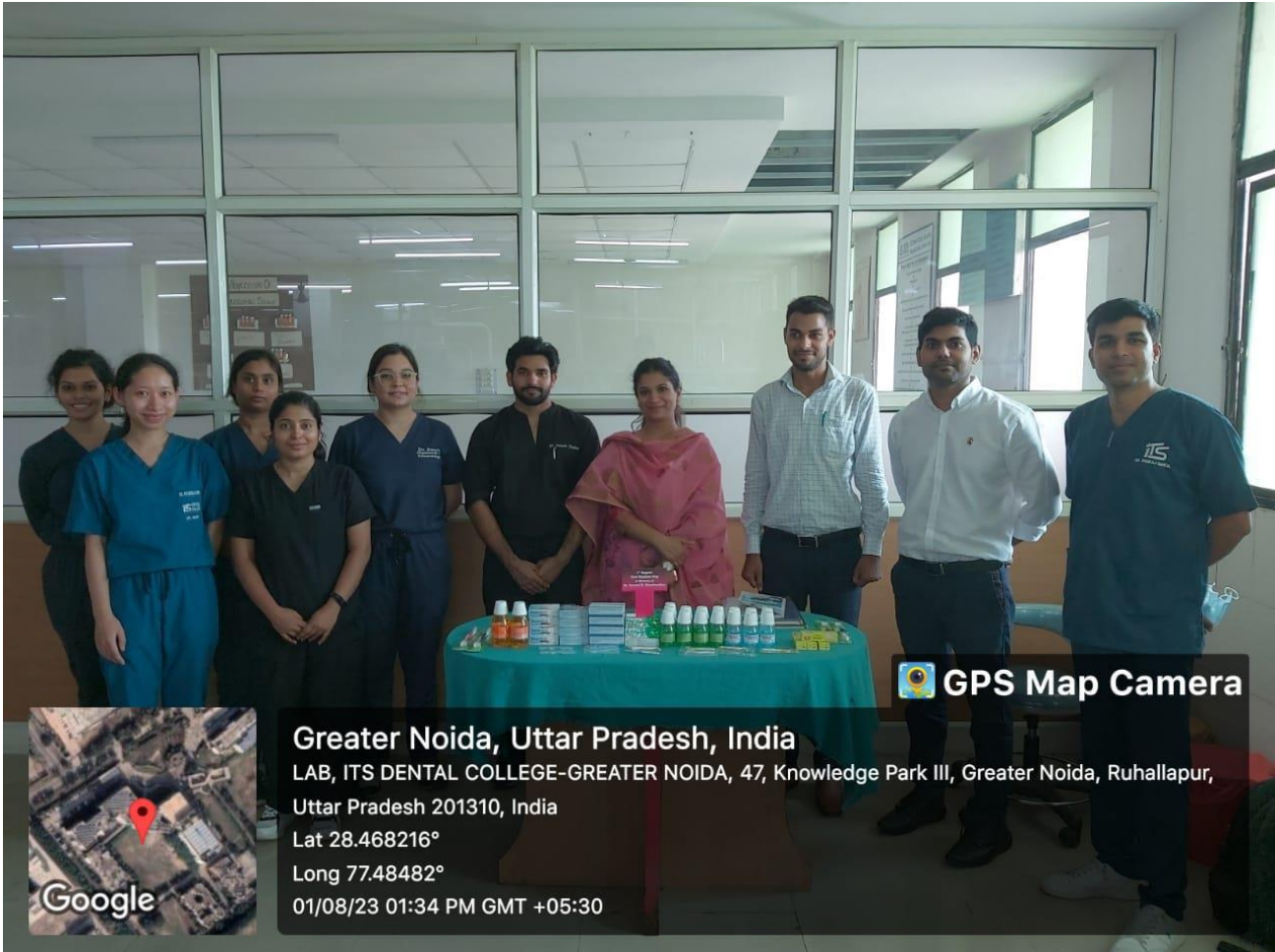

### **About the Programme**

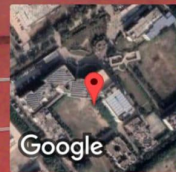
