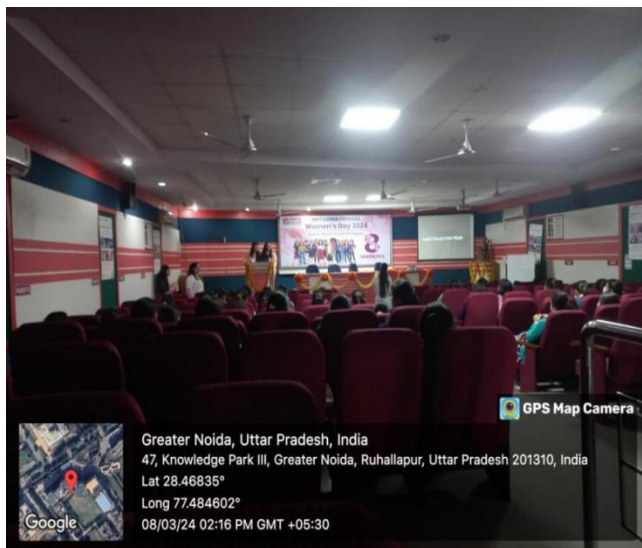
Report - Women's Day

ABSTRACT

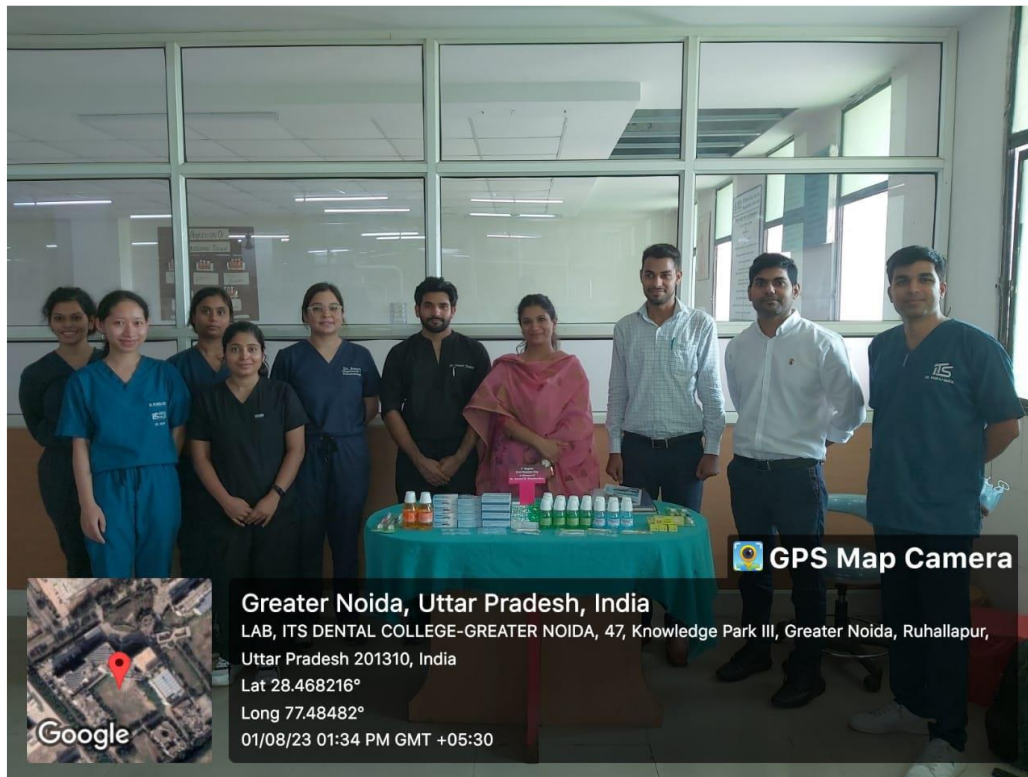
Department of Periodontics and Oral Implantology (ITS Dental College, Greater Noida) celebrated Oral Hygiene week from 1st to 7th August 2023.
