
#### Report on Feedback Received from Students


#### 1. How satisfied are you with your institute?


2. How do you grade your institute's faculty members on the their academic skills and ability to impart the cognitive and clinical knowledge:


3. How do you grade your institute's faculty members on their general behaviour, conduct, ethics and professionalism:


4. Do you think that the use of PPTs over black and board is more advantageous?



























































1. How satisfied are you with the quality of education you were imparted in your institute?



2. Do you think that more emphasis on practical/interaction/usage of multiple teaching aids-based learning is encouraging over the conventional black-board methodologies?



3. Do you think the number of hours of exposure was balanced with didactic lectures and pedagogy?





4. How do you grade your institute's infra-structure, departments, availability and accessibility of material, common-rooms, library, canteen etc?








### Report on Feedback Received from Students



2. Do you think that more emphasis on practical/interaction/usage of multiple teaching aids-based learning is advantageous?



3. Do you think the number of hours of exposure was balanced with didactic lectures and pedagogy?




4. Do you think that the academic-restructuring(interactive teaching) is more beneficial over the conventional teaching?

5. Do you think splitting the batches to smaller numbers is beneficial for learning?


